Presently there are 200 million people and if the rate of increase in the population remains the same, then it will be almost double by the year 2025 leading to add pressure on the groundwater resources. Also, the rapid depletion of groundwater may worsen the water crisis in Pakistan's major cities causing a drought-like situation.


